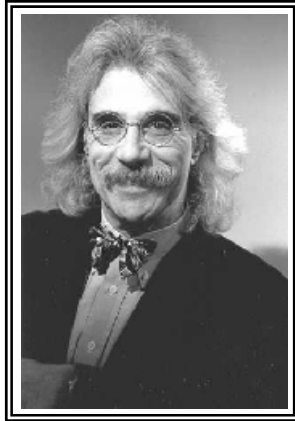


LAWRENCE B. WERLIN, M.D., F.A.C.O.G.

Practicing in Orange County since 1982, Dr. Lawrence B. Werlin is a nationally noted specialist in Reproductive Endocrinology & Infertility. He is founder and Medical Director of Coastal Fertility Medical Center, in Irvine and Aliso Viejo.

Prior to opening his private practice, Dr. Werlin was the Founder and Director of the Hoag Memorial Hospital Fertility Services, which started in January 1986. He has also served as Assistant Professor in the Division of Reproductive Endocrinology & Infertility at UCI, from 1982 to 1986, and is presently a member of the Clinical Faculty.

Among his many accomplishments, Dr. Werlin was honored as the recipient of the National Fellowship in Reproductive Medicine, and served as the National Fellow in Reproductive Medicine at the National Institutes of Health. He served as Chairman of the Validation Committee for the Society for Assisted Reproductive Technologies from 1990 to 1999.

Dr. Werlin has been listed in the Orange Coast Magazine as one of Orange County's Top Doctors (1996, 1998, 1999 and 2000 and 2003). He was selected by his peers to be listed as Orange County's Best Doctor in Infertility for 2000-2003. Dr. Werlin has been accepted as a life member of the National Registry of Who's Who in America, Who's Who in Medicine & Healthcare, and has been selected to the Best Doctor's in America. He has authored numerous abstracts and articles in peer review journals in his subspecialty, and is currently a reviewer for the journal "Fertility & Sterility."

Dr. Werlin is a member of the American Society for Reproductive Medicine and the Society of Assisted Reproductive Technologies, an organization in which he has held national offices since 1990. He is also a member of the Pacific Coast Fertility Society.
